Network Change Summary:		
<p>Copper facilities which serve a portion of the North Greenhills, Ohio Wire Center (GRHLOHNG) will be removed and replaced with fiber facilities. This network modification is being undertaken in conjunction with road improvements to Pippin Road under supervision of Hamilton County (North Section Pippin Road project: HAM-CR90-1.84 Ph 2). Widening of the road will force a reset of all pole lines. The new pole line will be set with fiber cable and the copper span on the old pole line will be retired. Copper distribution facilities, including drops will be replaced with fiber throughout the project area.</p>		
Description of type of changes planned:		
<p>There are two F1 copper cables of 900 pairs and 1500 pairs respectively that will be replaced with fiber facilities. This span extends from an area just south of the intersection of Pippin and Springdale Roads, south to the intersection of Pippin and Compton Roads. In addition, F2 distribution from the following Serving Area Cabinets (SAC) will be removed and replaced with fiber facilities, as will the F3 drops from these facilities:</p>

Description of Reasonably Foreseeable Impact of the Planned Changes:			
After the copper distribution facilities are retired and removed, Cincinnati Bell will no longer offer copper-based UNEs. To the extent required by applicable agreements and federal law, Cincinnati Bell will offer to requesting carriers a 64kbps voice grade channel over fiber loops that have been deployed where copper loops have been retired.
